Benefits of Move Redmond Membership

Advocate for Move Redmond members on Eastside Transportation Issues

- Monitor transportation policies, decisions, and legislation affecting members.
- Represent the interests of member companies to local and state agencies by participating on committees and by drafting letters and providing testimony to decision makers.
- Provide input into key local policies, programs, such as the Transportation Management Plan, Commute Trip Reduction, along with organizations like King County Metro, Sound Transit, and the Washington State Department of Transportation.
- Win recognition for Move Redmond members success by issuing press releases and nominating programs for awards.
- Pursue grants from public and private sources to support Move Redmond member's programs.
- Build coalitions and cooperative relationships with members, community groups, public agencies, other Eastside TMA's and similar organizations.

Convener of Transportation Partners and Members

- Provide a forum through meetings and workshops for members to learn more about transportation improvements, policies, and decisions affecting Redmond.
- Convene regular meetings of all designated Employee Transportation Coordinators from Move Redmond members to share strategies.
- Connect Employee Transportation Coordinators to each other and transportation resources though our email list

- Provide timely updates to members on transportation activities, issues and developments that affect members and their commuters.

Direct Service Provider to Move Redmond Members

- Provide printed marketing materials to support efforts in promoting transit, biking, walking, telework and carpooling to work.
- Provide one transportation event at Member's worksite for employees.
- Assist Member in undertaking additional transportation events
- Advise in the development and implementation of transportation programs and services that meet Member's needs.
- Assist with the application for grants to provide incentives, transit passes or physical improvements for Member's commuters to walk, bike, carpool, telework or take transit.
- Publish regular online newsletters for distribution to Member's commuters.

For Commute Trip Reduction law affected employers or sites with a Transportation Management Plan

- Provide training to Member staff on City of Redmond's Transportation Management Program requirements and process.
- Provide training to Member staff on Washington State's Commute Trip Reduction requirements and process.
- Assist Member in transportation survey distribution and collection, if applicable.
